OBJECTIVES:

- Possibly sponsor a new Interact Club in the Hondo High School.
- Purchase and deliver Rotary oriented coloring books to lower grade students at Hondo and D'Hanis schools.
- Continue to participate with the Hondo High School Fellowship of Christian Athletes and partially fund their social projects as appropriate.
- Volunteer to assist Hondo Public Library in pool party for children's reading program.

OBJECTIVES:

- Continue to strive for club to become a 100% Paul Harris Fellow club.
